The colors used in the painting are purely made from natural ingredients. The white color extract from seashells was powdered soaked to make the white paste. The color green is made from the green leaf and green stones. Red is made from a local stone called Hingula. Another stone named Khandaneela was used to extract the color blue. The yellow is made from, stone named Hartal. Black is extracted by burnt coconut shell. These five colors are also called Pancha Tatwa. Every color has its own significance, as the white illustrates Laughter (Hasya), Red stands furious, astonishment in yellow,

The hair of the mouse and Buffalo used to make brushes and tied to the end of a bamboo stick.

The floral border makes the art astonishingly beautiful.

Mahadev is known as the destroyer and Krishna is known for preserving. Lord Mahadev symbolizes anger and the utmost power of decision-making. Krishna the preserver portrayed as blue-skinned, takes incarnation whenever the earth needs a balance of good over bad. Krishna is the eighth incarnation of Lord Bishnu.

Elucidation of the Pattachitra Painting:

- The above painting depicted Dancing Ganesha with Dholok Pattachitra Painting.
- Nritya Ganapati is regarded as the 15th among the 32 different forms of Ganapati. The Sanskrit word 'Nritya' means 'dance.' Nritya Ganapati, as the name suggests, is a dancer or a happy dancer, and thus represents the relaxed and enjoyable form of the Lord.
- Canvas preparation is done by coating the clothing with a mixture of chalk and gum.
- After that, it is smoothed with two different stones and then the cloth is dried.
- Pattachitra is an ancient art of living art form of Odisha.

Significance of Lord Ganesha:

- He is the son of Shiva and his consort Parvati, both of human form and yet he bears the head of an elephant.
- It is said that when Shiva was away. She decided to create a child and did this by forming him, by molding a substantial accumulation of her body dirt. And so Ganesh was born and Parvati was happy and occupied.
- He is usually worshipped as the elephant-headed god of commencements.
- His name Ganesha means Lord of the people, where Gana means people and Isha means leader.
- Lord Ganesha was born on the Chaturthi Tithi of Shukla Paksha in the Bhadrapada month.



Another form of Pattachitra apart from painting on cloth, Talapatra Chitra is engravings over a leaf of palm. Consists of inscribing letters or an artistic design on palm leaves. The process involves unripe palm leaves from trees cut and dried, soaked, and again dried until getting they leave to harden. After then, stretch and inscribe on the leaf strip. then lamp black is rubbed all over the leave, to give fine black color to fine lines. Natural colors are used to highlight the figures. Black is extracted from the lamp, yellow from hairtail stone, red from singular stone, white from conch shells, green is from leaf, and green stones. Goddess Laxmi the helpmate of Lord Vishnu. The Goddess of wealth, fortune, beauty, and purity. She is said to be born from churning the ocean of milk, from the tug of war between God and Demon. She is the source of all forms of wealth. She is inseparable from Lord Vishnu. Whenever Lord Vishnu incarnates on earth she is also born as his spouse. When Lord incarnates as Vamana, Rama, Krishna, Parashurama, she also appeared as the Padma, Sita, Rukmani, Dharani. She is often depicted as a beautiful woman standing on a lotus flower. Draped in a red saree, bespangle with ornaments. Holding a lotus in both hands, right hand gesturing the Abhay mudra while in left she is shown holding Amrita Kalasa (pot of immortality). Making it ready to receive the paint, the process involves unripe palm leaves from trees cut and dried, soaked, and again dried until getting they leave to harden. After then, stretch and inscribe on the leaf strip, then lamp black is rubbed all over the leaf. The sourcing and application of colors and materials are purely natural. Five colors white, red, yellow, green, black, known as Pancha Tatwa been used to color the Picture. The white color gets by soaking, drying, and churning seashell, The red extract from a stone named Hingula, a local stone Haritlal used for yellow, Green used from leaves and green stones, and black is obtained from lamp soot, or either from burning coconut shell. 120 more colors are used by mixing of the Pancha Tatwa color. The hair of, mouse, buffalo, and Keya roots are used to make the brush for the painting. And tied to a bamboo stick for the brush handle Lord Ganesha has always seen showering bestow on his devotees, with wisdom and prosperity. His body symbolizes different spiritual meanings. The posture with one foot on the ground and

another folded up conveys to us, that even if living in a materialistic world we must be attached to spirituality. The big head is a symbol of intellect. His big ears symbolize a wise person who hears everything. His trunk above the mouth teaches us to work more and talk less. prayer beads symbolize concentration on life and knowledge should continuously hunt for, the axe represents cut off all obstruction of the devotee. The belly of Lord Ganesha represents the whole cosmos, which he holding back with a snake around the waist. The mouse is a greedy animal that keeps searching and nibbling whatever he finds, a representation of human desire and pride that get out of control, and destroys the goodness of the human. So by controlling the mouse Lord Ganesha depicts that our desires, emotion, pride need to be in our control. **Care:** Use a soft cloth for dusting the surface.




