- In this statue, Lord Krishna is seen dancing over the heads of the serpent while holding the tail in one hand & flute in the other.
- The little Krishna is adorned with many pieces of jewelry, finely engraved on his body.
- The statue has the appealing power to draw your attention at the first glance, constructed from a single stone to showcase the proficiency of the artist who engraved the delightful sculpture.

Kaliya Damana:

- Lord Krishna, is the incarnation (8th) of Lord Vishnu, the preserver of the universe.
- Kaliya Nag was a venomous serpent who choose the river Yamuna as his home and churned and bubbled the water with his venom.
- In the phase where Lord Krishna was living in Vrindavan. One fine day Krishna played with balls near the bank of the Yamuna, suddenly the ball landed on the Yamuna.
- Krishna jumped into the river without a second thought.
- Where Kaliya tried to grab Krishna but got tired when Krishna grew his body so big.
- Lord Krishna grabbed the serpent's tail and dragged him to the surface of the river.
- He then plays flute in one hand and started dancing on his head, while holding on to his tail in his other hand as shown in the above picture.

Make your outdoor embellishment more eye-catching:

- The Northeast zone is beneficial to place the statue as per Vaastu.
- Placing it in the middle of a sprouting fountain will be very eye-catching.
- Place it on the center point of your garden combining it with some small flowery plants around the stone sculptures.
- Placing it at the end of the path using a stepping stone also is a welcoming idea.
- Complement the statue with curated bushes and hedges, making the garden beautiful.

Clean off guide:

- Wet the statue all over with a hose in gentle mode.
- Using a sponge or bristle brush gently scrub the surface.
- Now using the hose give the stone sculptures a final shower for any residue.
- Occasional cleaning of the stone sculptures (twice a year) remains keeps the beauty of the statue for years.
