Made him disturbed while he saw a monk walking peacefully, and calmly. He realized that the pain and suffering are awaited all humanity, it won't spare even a prince or king like him. That is when he gave up his lavish life left the palace in search of a solution to relieve from the universal suffering. Lord Buddha then devoted himself to deep meditation, in the first stage he saw past life and the cycle of birth and rebirth(samsara). In the second stage, he found the law that guides the endless cycle (Dharma). In the third stage, he saw the consequences of good and bad (Karma) and gained enlightenment, a perfect state of wisdom, and intellectual. which he later share with others on how to achieve it. The above statue depicts the form of Bhumisparsha mudra of Buddha while meditating, there is a story that lies behind this mudra. While meditating there is a demon named Mara who intervene Buddha from achieving the final goal, Lord Buddha then touches and called the earth for a witness, the earth goddess appeared and dislodge the demon and bears the witness of the enlightenment. In this form Lord Buddha is seen sitting on a lotus platform with right hand held flats on the right knee touching the earth, while the left hand resting on his lap, palm face-up. Eyes are closed in deep meditation.

The most favorable benefit of this mudra is that will support you in any room you want to place. As it represents wisdom and calmness, it helps to transform agitation into wisdom. Beneficial for health issues. **Placement:** To rip the benefits place him facing east, as Lord Buddha used to meditate at sunrise. You can also place him in the study, living, library, mantle, on a desk too. as it represents the earth element you can place him in the center too. **Care:** The easiest nonporous material is soapstone, so no excessive cleaning attention is required. Use a broom or a piece of cloth to dust the surface is enough to maintain the shine.

He realized that it's a human fate and no individual can escape from this, everyone will

be subject to get old, sick, and dead. At the same time, he saw a holy monk who was walking with an expression of peacefulness on his face. All these incidents made him search for an answer to all the suffering a human faces. At the age of 29, he gave up his royal and lavish life and left for the spiritual quest. For six consecutive years, he follows many practices, extreme starvation, and self-deprivation but found no result to his quest, so he found a middle way from the two extremes and sat beneath a fig tree, in deep meditation, and finally achieve enlightenment. Mudra is essential which evokes particular ideas of his gestures significant to his life. The blessing Buddha statue is seen sitting with a double lotus pose. The right hand is raised in front of the chest, faced outward. This represents protection or a shield overcoming fear. Protection from fear, anger, and mirage. Left-hand lies up on left lap extended upward, symbolizing generosity. As the pose of blessing Buddha gives a feeling of divine protection, so you can place him in any room or area you want positive energy/Blessing or protection. It also cures the Vaastu-related default so keeping a statue from blessing Buddha in that area may help to overcome the defect. **Placement:** Keeping the Blessing Buddha statue at the entrance of your home, will help to keep all the negative and evil forces outside. Face him outside the entrance. **Care:** Gentle dusting with a cloth or soft brush, enough to keep your statue away from dirt.

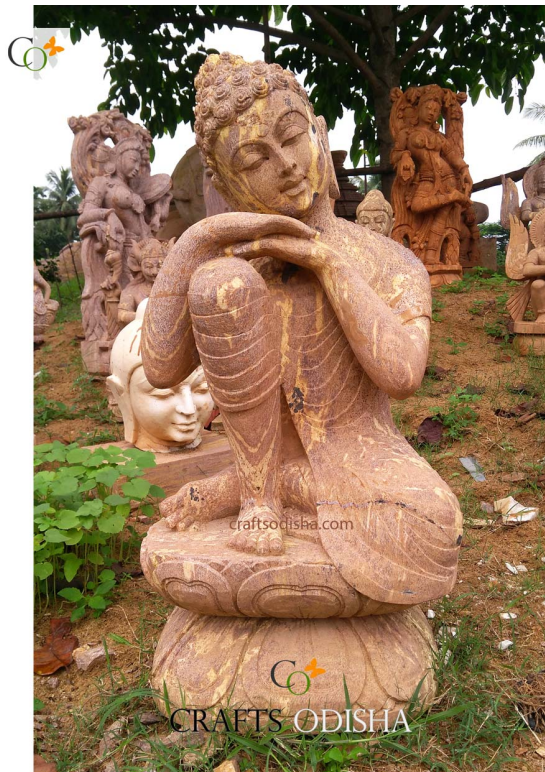

Born into a royal family, upbrought with all lavish and luxury, married and had a son, until the age of twenty-nine he was unwitting of bitter facts of worldly affairs. One day he went to Kapilavastu, on the way he saw an old person, a sick man, and a corpse taken to the cremation ground each for the first time in his life. Which disturbed him to the core, while returning he also encountered a sage who walking in the street with a peaceful expression on his face. These experiences changed his looking into life, Lord Buddha realized that no wealth or pleasure will protect him from facing the universal suffering of a human face. So he left his lavish life to find a way to overcome the suffering "Dukha".

For six long years, he followed many, teachers, severe starvation, self-deprivation, yoga practice, getting no result from all his practices so he finally found the middle way, by avoiding the extremes. He sat beneath a banyan tree, with deep meditation and concentration he attained enlightenment. In this pose, Buddha is seen sitting on a lotus platform with both legs folded, in the Vajrasana pose. The lotus signifies his ability to grow even in dirty water likewise every human has the potential to overcome suffering or any difficulty. Both hands are held on the lap upon each other. Eyes are completely closed in deep concentration. The Meditation form is widely known as the Amitabha mudra, which "means the boundless light". This form generally represents the focus concentration. Beneficial for people seeking peace and calm in their life, also helpful in improving meditation skills. You can consider the statue to be a spiritual gift for your loved ones. **Placement:** Buddha meditates while the sun rises so always keep him facing the east, where the sun rises. You can be considered placing the Buddha statue in the northeast or Southwest sector, as it activates the earth element. You can opt to place it in Living, prayer, serenity, library, office, or any quiet corner of the house. **Care:** The advantage of pink stone is it is a nonporous material. Wipe the surface with a dry cloth or broom is enough to maintain the glossiness.

During the meditation, their heavy rainfall came and Lord Buddha was about to sweep away in the floodwater, there is when a

seven head snake saw this and wrapped around him his coil and uplifted him from the flood, and spread the hood over the head of Lord Buddha to protect him. The above statue depicts the moment where the seven-headed snake was in his protection, Lord Buddha is seen sitting in the coil of the serpent in a double lotus pose. Both hands are held near the chest forming a circle with the thumb and index of both hands. The circle represents the wheel of Dharma. A dharma wheel has **three basic parts**, the hub, the rim, and the spokes.

- **Hub:** Moral discipline.
- **Rim:** Meditative concentration and mindfulness.
- **Spokes:** If a wheel has four spokes it represents the four noble truths and if the wheel has eight spokes it represents the eightfold part.

This form of Buddha is also known as Dharmachakra Buddha. which means the wheel of Dharma. Lord Buddha's first sermon was based on the four noble truths and the eightfold part. Beneficial for people seeking academic and spiritual growth in their life. As it represents wisdom and intellectual it improves the peacefulness and calmness in the surrounding. It can be a perfect gifting option for your dear ones. **Placement:** Northeast or southwest is favorable to place teaching Buddha statue. Always face him east while placing. **Care:** Nonporous materials like soapstone is easy to keep clean. Dusting should be done using a cloth or broom.

A man who has wakened fully, a man who discovered to bring off wisdom, empathy, and deliverance from suffering. A crown prince left everything behind in search of enlightenment and spent the life rest teaching others. The statue here depicted his teaching phase, where he delivered his first sermon, in Sarnath. The first sermon presents the recapitulation of suffering and the way to overcome it. It is called the **four noble truths**.

Those **four noble truths** are:

1. Suffering
2. Cause of suffering
3. end of suffering
4. the path that leads to the end of suffering

Suffering the "**Dukha**" or unsatisfactoriness, suffering is three types according to Lord Buddha first suffering from physical and psychological pain. Second, the blissful state, which is not permanent it changes with time, and the third is suffering arising from the failure. Next is the cause of suffering, which arises from our craving for desire, fantasy, and avaricious. End of suffering means the way out of suffering, if we put an end to our desire, ego, and on dukkha then we will get our self free from unsatisfactoriness. And finally, the path that leads to the end of suffering lies in the eighth-most ethical habit known as the eightfold path.

The **eight habits** include

1. Right understanding
2. Right thought
3. Right speech
4. Right action
5. Right livelihood
6. Right effort
7. Right mindfulness
8. Right concern.

These habits restrain us from lying stealing and committing violent acts, the paths help us to control; our self and not be harmful to others by maintaining social harmony.

Here Buddha is sitting on a lotus platform, with Vajrasana pose, right hand on chest level turned palm out forming a circle with the tip of index and thumb, the left hand resting on the lap of left leg forming the same circle with the finger, palm out. Widely known as Dharmachakra Buddha.

The teaching Buddha represents eternal knowledge and enlightenment so keeping a statue of teaching Buddha is favorable for people seeking academic success and spiritual learning.

Placement: Northeast delivers the pious zone of serenity. The Buddha should always face the east to rip more positive results. **Care:** Keep the statue clean with the help of a cloth or broom will not let the dirt settle on it.
