His four arms, each of which carries its own important spiritual significance. First, the goad is in the upper right hand, the rope is in the upper left hand, the sweet is in the lower left hand, and then the hand posing varada mudra. Now going clockwise first the dilemma is removed (goad), then the purpose is fixed (noose), then soul delighted( sweet), and final blessing of protection from all hardship (mudra). Lord Ganesha is adroit to any cubbyhole of the world because he is riding his mount rat who can crawl into tiny holes and alleys. Exact role desires and ego play in human life. It can easily enter into our life and gulp down all the good we have within us. So the rat represents desires and ego which need to be conquered. He holds the kundalini shakti, our individual power of wholeness in his waist with a serpent belt. He is sitting with one leg on the ground and another leg folded up, indicating while performing our duties of a common man we should not forget the godhood within us. Want to seek wisdom then lord Ganesha supreme god to be admired for wisdom. He is the god of fortune and wealth, remover of obstacles, and negativity from your life whether it is personal or professional. Apart from providing material

and spiritual guidance, the Ganesha god statue is perfect for home office decor, simple and elegant. The Ganesha stone sculptures will add meaning to your space. **Placing:** According to Vaastu northeast direction is the best place for the idol. However east and west are also considered to be favorable.
