The statue of Annapurna:

- The debonair statue of Goddess Laxmi is standing on a double-layer lotus plinth.
- The sculpture is magnificently made out of a single granite stone. The mere smile and beautiful expression of the statue are enough to glue the onlooker.
- The drop-dead gorgeous statue is carved by the artisans of Odisha, where stone engraving is globally famous for its complex design.

Laxmi; The prominent Goddess of Hindu culture

- Goddess Laxmi is the consort of Lord "Vishnu" the god of perseverance, the pair often called as Laxmi-Narayana.
- Known as the Goddess of wealth and prosperity of every Hindu household.
- She arises from the churning of the milk ocean.
- The lotus represents divine wisdom.

- She is widely worshipped in Dhanteras and Diwali, for welcoming prosperity and wealth into home and business.

Direction and placement suggestions:

- The godly statue should be placed in the North or east part of the Northeast corner of the home or office.
- You can use it in the temple for Puja or place it at the entrance of any shrine.
- It is auspicious to place it in your office, home, restaurant, shop, etc.
- You can also place the stone sculptures in your garden, fountain, or park, or any outdoor embellishment.

The graciousness of keeping the stone sculptures:

- She protects her devotee from illness and bestows with health, wealth, and progeny.
- The word "Laxmi" is derived from the word Lakshya which means ambition, goal, or target thus, thus, she helps a person to attain prosperity.
- She is also known as "Moksha Pradayini", freeing one from the liberation(cycle of death and rebirth).

Few tips for cleaning the statue:

- The dignified structure is made from durable material Granite
 - Granite stone is weather-resistant and requires super low maintenance.
 - For cleaning wipe the surface down with a piece of dry cloth or broom.
 - The cleaning should be carried every second day, to keep the dust away from the stone sculptures.
