- The caparison(Nettipattam), pieces of jewelry to adorn the neck and legs are all beautifully carved in the stone sculpture.

The connection of the scared piece with spirituality:

- According to Hindu mythology, the elephant represents power and wisdom.

- The elephant is always associated with Lord Ganesha, the elephant-headed god, who bestows their devotee with knowledge and fortune.
- The elephant is the vehicle of Lord Indra known as "Airavat".
- He also serves as the vehicle of Goddess Laxmi, in many Hindu scriptures, she is widely named "Gaja Laxmi" (Gaja means elephant).
- Lord Buddha is also associated with the elephant because his mother had a dream of an elephant before giving birth to him.

Tips for placement possibility with benefits:

- Placing elephants at the main entrance facing outward is considered to bring luck and prosperity. You can place it on each side of the entrance.
- In-office, work station, wear house, it should be placed in the northern corner for career and growth.
- The placement can be eye-catching if you place it by the sidewalk of any park, restaurant, garden, and landscaping.
- At the zoo and the wide entrance of any palace, the statue can be placed.
- You can pair them as much as you require for your desired decoration.
- In most Hindu temples, we have seen elephants at the entrance. So the placement of the sacred statue in temples is widely auspicious.
