- Seen with four arms where he is holding a goad, Modak, a noose, and a broken tusk.
- Carved with a distressed look the statue has done with delicate carving and etching.

- "Gana" means common people, and "Isha" means leader so "Ganesha" is head of people.
- He rides a mouse as his Vahana.

- when Goddess Parvati took a bath and prohibit to keep anyone from disturbing her, she made a child out of the dirt from her body and gave it to life.
- meanwhile, Lord Shiva arrived and wanted to barge at goddess Parvati, the child Ganesha barred him from that which makes Lord Shiva so angry and he cuts off the child's head.
- Later with the request of Goddess Parvati, Lord Shiva restored the life by placing an elephant calf on the boy's body and thus Lord Ganesha was created.
- The month of Bhadrava Shukla paksha Chaturthi is marked as his birth.
